on the LCD panel. And with the Quick Registration function, you can enjoy brilliant registrations created by world-renowned organists.




Innovative Functions Create New Potential for Organ Music

A floppy disk drive lets you load commercially available Standard MIDI Files (SMFs) and view song lyrics or notation right on the LCD, and lyrics can even be displayed on an external monitor using the built-in video output.
